2010 Breeding Contract for Windrise Payton. Owned by Sherri Mabie, Windrise Morgan Farm. Breeding fee for Windrise Payton is \$400 for Morgan/Arabian/Morab mares, \$300 for all other breeds. This includes the booking fee of \$125.00 (non-refundable), booking fee due when signed contract is sent to Windrise. On premises mare care is available at \$10.00 dry/\$12.00 wet per day. A handling fee per heat cycle, A.I. or hand breeding of \$75.00 may be charged if the mare is problem breeder or is hard to handle during the breeding process. Additional fees for A.I. are required per collection, these fees are to cover the costs associated with the additional costs of offering this option. Please see below for other related fees and conditions.

Windrise Morgan Farm agrees to these conditions as stallion owner:

1. Live foal guarantee. Mares remaining open at the end of the 2010 breeding season, may return the following breeding season. A breeding soundness exam for the mare may be requested, if need of such is indicated.
2. Mare shall be bred only to the Morgan stallion, Windrise Payton.
3. Stallion shall be current on all vaccines and worming.
4. Stallion has recorded DNA on file with the American Morgan Horse Association.
5. A stallion service report will be filed with the American Morgan Horse Association at the end of each calendar year. Certificates and/or signatures for registration applications will be provided to the mare owner, or completed forms returned to the mare owner upon full payment of breeding fee and other charges incurred.
6. Windrise will do its best to get your mare in foal and will work with your veterinarian to ensure every possible option is explored to achieve a pregnancy. All veterinary fees incurred are the Mare Owner's responsibility. If for any reason the mare contracted for the breeding is unable to conceive, one mare substitution will be allowed. Refunds of stud fees will not be paid if your mare is unable to conceive. If you do not have another mare, Windrise may have a mare available for you to lease through our On The Farm Mare Lease Program.

Mare owner agrees that the following conditions be met before the mare is brought over for breeding.

1. Mare shall be current on normal vaccines and worming. Mare shall have current Coggins Certificate or she will not be allowed to unload.
2. Mare shall have recent cultures, within the calendar year, with normal results. It is highly recommended that you have a breeding soundness exam including ultrasound of the uterus done.
3. Mare shall have shoes pulled before she arrives. If they are not, they will be removed before she is bred and an extra handling fee will be assessed.
4. Mare should be halter broke and able to stand tied unattended for short periods of time.
5. Mares with foals should provide a halter for the foal, preferably the foal shall have some halter training and basic handling.
6. Stallion breeding fee, minus the booking fee, shall be paid 50% upon arrival for breeding. The remainder shall be paid in full before the mare leaves Windrise. If utilizing AI, full breeding fee shall be paid before shipment is sent. Ultrasound can determine pregnancy as soon as 16 days after the last date of heat and breeding. Approximate cost for ultrasound procedure is \$65.00 provided by Athens Veterinary Service. This does NOT include any medications that may be required if mare requires sedation for the procedure. You are welcome to utilize any veterinary service you wish, Windrise is not aware of the costs of procedures at other veterinary clinics. Windrise will set up an appointment for this procedure at the owner's request/approval. Mare owner is responsible for all fees incurred and shall pay the veterinary clinic directly for the ultrasound visit.
7. Mare owner shall be responsible for any additional services that are required during the duration of said mare's stay at Windrise. Should she require veterinary or farrier care, owner will be advised and asked for their approval before any procedure is done. The exception is if there was an emergency case and the owner is unreachable.

Special Services:

PLEASE NOTE: A.I. collection is only offered from mid-April through mid-August. Exceptions can be possible, but there is the possibility of troubles attaining a viable shipment. There may be extra costs ensued due to the natural breeding cycles and the climate. These costs will be the responsibility of the mare owner. Frozen semen may be available by request only. Frozen semen may carry an additional fee to cover the additional cost associated with the freezing process. Shipment of frozen semen is contingent on the availability of the proper type of shipping unit. There may be additional charges for shipping, which shall be paid by mare owner.

Shipping semen to most parts of the country will be by FedEx or UPS next day air these fees vary by location and delivery date. A.I. container deposit and fee deposit is \$400.00 to use the Equitainer. This deposit is handled through Athens Veterinary Service where we do the collections. Collection fees are to be paid by the mare owner directly to the veterinary service. Deposit will be returned after container is received back at the veterinary service in good condition. They request the container be shipped back as soon as possible. Styrofoam shipping boxes are also available for a nominal fee. Athens Veterinary Service will bill the mare owner for the current cost of this type of container. These containers require no deposit and need not be returned. Be sure to check with your veterinarian to discuss which type of container he or she feels is best for your climate.

Special Rush Fee: If you do not give us a minimum of 7 days notice of mare's heat, and a minimum of 48 hours before bringing a mare or requesting a shipment, a special rush fee will be charged of \$25/\$50 in addition to regular fees. Time is required to prepare and coordinate with the veterinary service. A suitable mare in standing heat must also be located. Prior notice allows timing of a mare's cycle for the collection process.

*** We have tried to keep all fees at a minimum. With your cooperation and communication, there will be a minimum of problems in breeding your mare. It is most important that you have your mare's breeding soundness evaluated by a qualified veterinarian before attempting to breed. It is also very important that the veterinarian on your end be comfortable with the procedures with a decent success rate. Many times a mare will not conceive because of the semen being mishandled before breeding. Please ask questions, become familiar with all aspects of the process before shipment is attempted. Things will go much smoother and you'll be better prepared if there is a delay or problem along the way. Be sure to let us know if problems of any sort are anticipated. Substitution mares will only be allowed with proper documentation and written approval.***
